## ELEVATOR STACKING



SUMMARY	Small groups of kids cooperate in stacking cups to defeat their opponents
SUPPLIES	<ul> <li>9 red cups for the red team</li> <li>9 blue cups for the blue team</li> <li>2 yellow cups (or any color other than red or blue)</li> <li>3-5 Kids per team</li> </ul>
SET UP	<ul> <li>Pick 3-5 kids for each team.</li> <li>Set up 9 cups in front of each team and the one yellow cup on the top of the stack.</li> </ul>
GAMEPLAY	<ol> <li>When the music starts, the first child in line takes the top cup, (the yellow cup) - from the top and place it on the ground (or table) by itself.</li> <li>The same child will then take the rest of their cups, all 9 at once, and place them on top of the ONE different colored cup. The cup should now be on the bottom of the stack instead of the top.</li> <li>This child will then step to the back of the line and the next person in line will do the same thing with the stack of cups, - remove the top cup, set it down, take the rest of the stack and set it on top of the removed cup.</li> <li>The yellow cup will start to move slowly back to the top of the stack if it is done right.</li> <li>The first team to get the ONE different colored cup back up to the top of their stack wins the round.</li> </ol>
