

SIX CORNERS



SUMMARY	This game is a classic that never seems to get old! The kids run to a corner and a die is rolled to see who is out!
SUPPLIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Large 6 sided die (large foam versions can be found on Amazon)• Number signs 1-6
SET UP	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Attach number signs 1-6 around your room as far from each other as possible.
GAMEPLAY	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Tell the kids to find a corner as you count down from 52. Any kids not in a corner after the countdown are out and must sit in a seat.3. Roll the die, the kids in the corner that is rolled are out ex: if you roll a 6 the kids in corner #6 are out.4. Players that are out must sit.<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Important: To prevent cheating and subsequent tattling make sure that the kids who are out are seated before anyone is allowed to move to a new corner.5. Once you are down to 6 players, repeatedly roll the dice till you have a winner. This is to prevent the last portion of the game from taking too long. This quickly gets you a winner and gets the rest of the class back in the game.
SUGGESTIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can play this as teams. Once everyone on a team is eliminated the opposite team wins.
