

SNOWBALL FIGHT

SUMMARY

The entire class throws paper wads creating a giant snowball fight!

SUPPLIES

- 2 pieces of paper for every child in class
- 2 small-medium size trash cans
- 1-minute timer (optional)

SET UP

- Pre-wad 2 pieces of paper for every child in class
- Divide the room into 2 using a line of chairs

GAMEPLAY

1. Divide the kids on each side of the room.
2. When the timer starts the kids throw the paper back and forth like a snowball fight!
3. When the timer stops everybody freezes.
4. Have the kids put the snowballs on their side into a separate trashcan. Count the snowballs (or just eyeball it). The team with the lowest number wins.

SUGGESTION

- The goal here is to have a good time. Don't stress too much about the counting, the winning and the losing if it isn't working out.
- Make sure at the end that you make a game of throwing all the paper away, so you aren't left with the job. It's easier for them, they are naturally closer to the ground 😊

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
